

## Cameron/Knight Street

### **Location**

Both streets are located just off Ainsworth Road approximately one mile from the town centre.

### **Transport**

There are several bus routes that run close to the area. Buses running from Bury to Bolton and from Bury to Ainsworth have stops close by.

The 471 bus runs along Bolton Road into Bury and into Bolton every 10 minutes during the day and every hour after 6.30PM.

Taxis and Minicabs: There are several operators in the area. The nearest is Tiger Taxis.

### **Details of the Properties**

There are only small 1 bedroom flats on these streets. Whilst some couples do live in these flats they are more ideally suited to single applicants.

28 x 1 bed ground floor flats

28 x 1 bed first floor flats

All of the properties have had double glazed windows and gas central heating fitted. The flats have lawned areas at the front (which are maintained by Six Town Housing) and rear communal areas.

### **Facilities**

There is an off licence and convenience store nearby. Take aways, a taxi rank and public houses are close by on Bolton Road.

**Drs:** The nearest Drs surgery is at the Mile Lane Health Centre about half a mile away.

**Dentists:** The nearest dental surgery is also on Mile Lane.

**Chemists:** The nearest chemist shop is on Ainsworth Road.

**Places of Worship:** Bolton Road Methodist , St Stephens C of E and Guardian Angels RC churches are all within walking distance.

The nearest Mosque is a mile and a half away on Walmersley Road.

**Police:** The Police station for Bury is at Irwell Street near to the town centre and just under a mile away.

**Popularity**

The upstairs flats are quite popular and are usually allocated to applicants in Band 1 or 2. Ground floor flats are usually allocated to elderly applicants or those with mobility problems in Bands 3 or 4.
