

Seedfield

The Seedfield estate is approximately 1 mile from Bury Town Centre. It is located off Walmersley Road, and the estate comprises Parkinson Street, Wooded and Woodward Close.

Transport

There is a local frequent bus service which runs along Walmersley Road into Bury Town Centre.

Details of the Properties

12 x 1 ground floor flats

11 x 1 first floor flats

34 x 1 bed bungalows

6 x 2 bed houses

1 x 3 bed houses

The bungalows and ground floor flats are mainly for the elderly or persons with mobility problems, whilst the first floor flats are mainly for persons 50 plus.

The flats are in 2 storey blocks with 4 flats in each. All the properties have UPVc double-glazed windows. The gardens to the bungalows are maintained by grounds maintenance.

Facilities

The nearest shop is the Co-op on Walmersley Road, which is within 5 minutes walking distance, there is a good range of shops further down Walmersley Road at its junction with Chesham Road, and Bury Town Centre is easily accessible by a regular Bus Service on Walmersley Road. There are Dental and Doctors Practises on Walmersley Road and also a wide range of Doctors practises in Bury Town Centre.

St Johns with St Marks Church is within walking distance on Walmersley Road and there are number of other Christian Churches in the centre of Bury. There are several local primary schools within walking distance, and High Schools and Bury College of further education are accessible by public transport.

The estate is adjacent to the Seedfield Site which has a range of courses available to all age groups.

Popularity

Seedfield estate is a popular estate mainly with the over 50's due to the large proportion of bungalow and ground floor accommodation. There is also an active TRA based in the area.
